UTION ORDERING A REFERENDUM ON THE CREATION OF BEAVERHEAD AMBULANCE SERVICES SPECIAL DISTRICT AND PROVIDING FOR THE ELECTION OF BOARD MEMBERS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADMINISTERING THE SPECIAL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, Mont. Code Ann. § 7-11-1003(1)(a)(ii) authorizes a governing body to order a referendum on the creation of a special district to serve the inhabitants within the special district, which referendum must be ordered and conducted in accordance with the provisions of Mont. Code Ann. § 7-11-1011; and,

WHEREAS, on January 19, 2021, the Board of County Commissioners of Beaverhead County, Montana (the "Board"), passed Resolution No. 2021-04 regarding its intention to order a referendum on the creation of the Beaverhead Ambulance Services Special District (the "Ambulance District") and determined (a) that public convenience and necessity required the formation of a special district to provide emergency medical and ambulance services to inhabitants and members of the public within the boundaries of the Ambulance District, and (b) that a public hearing should be held with respect to submitting the question on formation of the Special District by ordering a referendum; and

WHEREAS, on January 25, 2021, the Board held a public hearing on ordering a referendum and placing the question of creation of the Ambulance District before the qualified electors of the Ambulance District. At the public hearing, public comments and written comments were received on the issue of ordering a referendum on the Ambulance District; and

WHEREAS, after considering the public and written comments, the Board determined sufficient public interest and need was shown for the Board to order a referendum on the creation of the Ambulance District and that the issue should be brought before the registered electors residing within the proposed Ambulance District; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Mont. Code Ann. § 7-11-1011(2)(d), in the resolution ordering a referendum on Ambulance District the Board must state whether the proposed Ambulance District is to be administered by the governing body or by an appointed or elected board; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the proposed Ambulance District will be administered by an elected board of five (5) qualified citizens who reside within the boundaries of the Ambulance District., the "Ambulance District Board".

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED, that a referendum on the creation of the Ambulance District shall be conducted on May 4, 2021 by a special purpose district election conducted in accordance with the provisions of Mont. Code Ann. Title 13, Chapter 1, Part 5, and shall be held by mail ballot to ask: "Shall the proposition to organize the Beaverhead Ambulance Services Special District be adopted?"; and

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IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED; the special purpose district election shall also provide for the election of five (5) qualified individuals who reside within the boundaries of the Ambulance District to administer the district. The election of the Ambulance District Board shall be conducted on May 4, 2021 by a special election which shall be held by mail ballot; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, in accordance with Mont. Code Ann. § 7-11-1011(2), the Board states as follows:

- The initial maximum annual assessment to fund the Ambulance District will be \$35.00 and will be imposed on each residential lot or parcel which contains a dwelling unit, each mobile home, and upon each developed commercial lot or parcel within the boundaries of the proposed Ambulance District. There shall be no assessment on agricultural or vacant properties with no dwelling unit.
- The activities to be funded through the annual assessments include hiring and retaining adequate staffing levels on all shifts, supplemented by volunteer staff, and at least a parttime manager to provide emergency medical services, emergency and non-emergency ambulance response services, and other emergency services beneficial to the inhabitants and members of the general public within the Ambulance District.
- The areas to be included in the proposed Ambulance District are those lands in Beaverhead County set forth in Exhibit A, and incorporated herein by reference. A map showing the boundaries of the Ambulance District is attached as Exhibit B, and incorporated herein by reference.
- (d) The proposed Ambulance District will be administered by an elected board of five (5) qualified citizens who reside within the boundaries of the Ambulance District.
- (e) The duration of the proposed Ambulance District Shall be limited to five (5) years from the initial assessment as referred to in Section 9 of Resolution 2021-04.

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
