**46-18-201, MCA, Permits fines to be satisfied by
food donations to a food bank program.**

**Beaverhead County Justice Court & Dillon City Court
are collaborating on this first-ever event!**

People making monthly payments on fines in Justice or City Courts may bring non-perishable food donations to the Court where the fines are owed and receive credit towards fines. Defendant's are ineligible to participate if they:

- Are paying only restitution
- Have an active warrant
- Have a Deferred Prosecution Agreement
- Are completing community service in lieu of fines.

People behind on payments (with no active warrant), may schedule a time to see the Judge and address their payment plan. The Court will hold the donation information until the Defendant appears for their Court date. Then Court will assess credit for the donation. Donated food will not be returned if defendant is determined ineligible.
